- ▶ how the model of care should operate in practice to support a person's wellbeing and recovery;
- ▶ how the model can potentially incorporate the needs of family and supporters;
- ▶ the operation of various elements of the model of care; and
- ▶ how the model should link with other services e.g. community-based services.
