



We are ready for **electronic prescribing**



For **medications** that you normally **collect from your local community pharmacy**, there are **two ways** to get an electronic prescription.

- 1 Direct to you** – During your consultation, we can send you a link to a QR code via SMS or email.
- 2 Direct to your Active Script List** – If your pharmacy has already set up an Active Script List for you, the prescription will automatically be added to it.



There are **two ways** to get your electronic prescription to your **local community pharmacy**

- 1 In person**
When you go into your local community pharmacy, show the QR code on your SMS or email so they can scan it **or** show your ID so they can access your active script list.
Remember: You can forward the SMS or email to a family member or carer to collect the medication on your behalf.

- 2 Remotely**
Ask your local community pharmacist if they allow QR codes to be forwarded directly to them via SMS or email. Or they may allow you to call ahead and request a medication be dispensed from your Active Script List as required.

Disclaimer: WA Health hospital pharmacies are unable to dispense prescriptions using QR codes. A paper prescription is still required.
